Most of the increase in the Master Association Assessment is associated with the new Verizon telecommunications agreement which adds telephone and internet services to the basic cable TV service previously provided. For most residents, this expaned service will be phased in over a 3 month period from March through May of 2018. Once your home is transitioned to the new bulk Verizon service, you will be able to cancel your present phone and internet services which should save you anywhere from \$40 to \$70 per month - which should exceed the increase in the MA assessment for 2018.
