HOW TO SHOW INCOMING PHONE CALLS ON YOUR TV

When watching TV, incoming telephone calls show up on your TV screen if you activate the feature in your FIOS TV Menu.


A couple of quick basics:

On the Remote Control, the Menu button is on the top left. You move the screen by using the cursor Up, Right, Down and Left - the blue Arrow points that surround the OK button.

- 1) Turn the TV on.
- 2) Push MENU on the Remote Control




3) The FIOS Interactive Menu opens



4) Move up to SETTINGS by using the blue arrow up button




5) On Settings, Arrow Right to enter the Settings Options




6) Navigate to SYSTEM and DOWN ARROW Button to move onto CALLER ID.




7) Enter CALLER ID Settings by using the RIGHT ARROW button.



8) Push OK to CHECK AVAILABILITY. The screen will show that you can have CALLER ID. Click ENABLE. The Screen will show that you will have calls show up on the TV.



9) Next, RIGHT ARROW DOWN to ALERT DURATION. RIGHT ARROW over to see Option. The Default is 2 Seconds and that is too quick. ARROW DOWN and select either 5 Second or 10 Second.



10) When you are done, CLICK THE GREEN OK BUTTON to return to Live TV. Make yourself a congratulatory beverage!
