Hershey’s Mill Landscape treats susceptible natural areas within boundaries of Hershey’s Mill for mosquito larvae. This treatment is completed monthly per Master Association directive.

MOSQUITOES WILL BREED IN ¼” OF STANDING WATER IF LEFT STANDING FOR FIVE (5) DAYS.

PLEASE SURVEY THE AREAS IN THE FRONT AND THE BACK OF YOUR HOME. EMPTY ALL CONTAINERS, BIRDBATHS, ETC. WEEKLY TO ELIMINATE THESE BREEDING SITES.
