Verizon

Verizon is back in the Village and doing final wiring, installation of boxes and can perform early turnovers if you want them to. You must set up an appointment with Verizon to order the equipment and services you want and then set up an appointment through Bill Kane at 610-430-8494 to have your service turned on. Once your new service is turned on and the old system disconnected, you can turn your Comcast equipment back in so you will stop the charges for their rental and stop their service.

If you opt for early changeover, there will be charges to you (which will significantly be reduced the end of March when we turn over to Verizon). These initial charges should be about what you are paying Comcast now, depending on services you want. If you have additional questions, you should meet with the Verizon Representative through appointments previously published.
